

Diversity video screening Oct. 27

The diverse voices and faces of The University of Western Ontario will light up the screen on Oct. 27 during the premiere of a film exploring issues of marginalization on university campuses.

Western's Caucus on Women's Issues is presenting the 'Voices of Diversity: creating a culture of safety, respect and belonging on campus' video at 4 p.m. in Conron Hall, University College Room 224. Members of the Western community and surrounding area are invited to attend.

The film was produced by a Video Steering Committee, which is a subcommittee of the Women's Caucus.

It was funded by the Provost's Office, the Women's Safety Committee, the Vice-President (Research and International Relations), the Centre for Research on Violence against Women and Children, the Student Development Centre, and the faculties of Social Science, Arts and Humanities, Education and Science.

It includes interviews conducted with faculty, students, administrators and support services staff at Western, as well as focus group sessions, discussing topics such as safety, violence against women on university campuses, Aboriginal and international student concerns and sexual orientation.

Copies of the DVD will be available at the premier for a one-time cost of \$15 for caucus members and participants in the video or focus groups.
